Christian Leaders, Scholars and Next Generation Convened for Combined Conversation on Spirit-empowered Christianity in the 21st Century

Dallas, TEXAS – Over 75 prominent International Christian leaders, scholars and next gens convened in Dallas this week at the **Empowered21 Combined Conversation**. This significant assembly served as the precursor to an international event in Tulsa, Oklahoma on April 8-10, 2010 called the **Empowered21: Global Congress on Holy Spirit Empowerment in the 21st Century**.

“The combined conversation was a unifying and intimate time for these three groups of world leaders. It is obvious there is a desperate cry from the next generation for spiritual fathers and mothers to help them fulfill their purpose. Likewise, Christian leaders desire to impart the legacy of Spirit-empowerment to spiritual sons and daughters. This inspirational time of dialogue and worship was a wonderful expression of what **Empowered21** can do for the Spirit Empowered Movement. We are finalizing plans for the Global Congress in April and I believe this event will be a catalyst for carrying the fire of the Spirit into the coming generations,” said Reverend Billy Wilson, who chairs **Empowered21** and is the executive director of the International Center for Spiritual Renewal.

Since December 2008, **Empowered21** (www.empowered21.com) has conducted 14 unique conversations with over 400 leaders, scholars and next gen leaders/students from 45 nations. Recently, **E21** has concluded three African conversations with over 100 leaders from 11 African nations. Other **E21** conversations have taken place in cities across America and in Nigeria, Kenya, Democratic Republic of Congo, Hong Kong, Germany and Chile. The next conversation will take place in Costa Rica.

Sujo John, 9/11 survivor and International Evangelist, said, “At this critical time in world history, God is preparing the Church to be released into a new dimension of influence, power and authority. The **E21** conversations are an acknowledgment of our acute need for God’s direction to reach this generation. I am honored to be a part of **Empowered21**.”

This group of extraordinary International Christian scholars, leaders and next gens are conversing, identifying trends and sharing emerging perspectives and insights on how the next generation will handle the deep issues facing Christians today and inspiration for the future of the Spirit-empowered movement.

Mart Green, President of Mardel Christian and Education said, “The level of engagement from these Christian leaders, scholars and next gens in Dallas was very invigorating, encouraging and inspiring. We are seeing that this next generation desires a relationship with spiritual mothers and fathers, infused by the Holy Spirit, to empower them to reach and impact a hurting and lost world.”

These conversations held throughout the world have included a leaders’ track chaired by Dr. Jack Hayford, former president of International Church of the Foursquare Gospel in Los Angeles, California, a scholars’ track chaired by Dr. Vinson Synan, Professor of church history and Dean Emeritus at Regent University School of Divinity and a next generation track chaired by Rob Hoskins, President of OneHope and member of the Oral Roberts University Board of Trustees.

There are a number of anticipated outcomes from these conversations on Spirit-empowerment and **Empowered21**. Questions and solutions for the future of the Spirit Empowered Movement will be brought forward. Increased effectiveness in reaching and engaging new generations will be achieved. Increased unity between traditional Pentecostals/Charismatics and emerging churches will be realized and the continued growth of Spirit-empowered ministries will be encouraged.
